
Manchester

Sport is for everyone - whether you have your sights set on elite competition, you're looking for a bit of fun, or you just want to find a good way to keep fit.

Whichever campus you're based at, you'll have access to fantastic sports facilities. In Preston, that includes both the Sir Tom Finney Sports Centre on campus and our Sports Arena nearby. If you're studying in Burnley or Westlakes you'll get membership of local facilities.

Sir Tom Finney Sports Centre

Home to an outstanding eight-court sports hall, squash court and two exercise studios, together with a large fitness suite, our Sports Centre has everything you need to get active. We offer fitness classes all year round - from Boxercise and Pilates, to Spinning and Zumba - and these are included in your membership.

Sports Arena

For outdoor sports, our Sports Arena is just outside the city centre - a short ride on our free shuttle bus. There you'll find an international standard athletics track, cycle track, FIFA and RFU accredited floodlit 3G pitches, various all-weather sports surfaces, tennis and netball courts, and facilities for strength and conditioning.

Sports membership

There's no need to spend money on expensive gym memberships! At the University of Central Lanacashire you can take advantage of our sports membership, giving you access to our Sir Tom Finney Sports Centre and Sports Arena (or nearby sports facilities if you're based at Burnley or Westlakes).

Join the team

Together with the Students' Union, we offer more than 40 student-led sports clubs for you to get involved in.
